

FSGLI
FAMILY SERVICEMEMBERS' GROUP LIFE INSURANCE
Protection for spouses and children

SGLI
SERVICEMEMBERS' GROUP LIFE INSURANCE
Provides low-cost term insurance coverage to servicemembers until 120 days after separating from service

SDVI
SERVICE-DISABLED VETERANS' INSURANCE
Protection for disabled Veterans who apply within 2 years of receiving a new service-connected disability rating

SGLI-DE
SERVICEMEMBERS' GROUP LIFE INSURANCE DISABILITY EXTENSION
Provides a two year extension of SGLI at no cost to Servicemembers who are totally disabled at the time of separation

VMLI
VETERANS' MORTGAGE LIFE INSURANCE
Provides mortgage life insurance to severely disabled Veterans who receive a VA Specially Adapted Housing Grant

VGLI
VETERANS' GROUP LIFE INSURANCE
Provides term insurance protection after separation from service for those who had SGLI while in the service

TSGLI
SERVICEMEMBERS' GROUP LIFE INSURANCE TRAUMATIC INJURY PROTECTION
Automatic coverage comes with SGLI for an additional \$1.00 a month for severely injured Servicemembers
