


Cost Breakdown for SAH Construction Projects

An important requirement for SAH construction projects is submitting an itemized cost breakdown. Providing a cost breakdown will help determine if the construction cost is appropriate for the proposed scope of work.

As an approved SAH builder, it is important that you provide a cost breakdown for all construction and remodeling projects. The **cost breakdown** is an itemized list of work and associated costs for the construction project and is an **integral part** of developing the **disbursement schedule**.

Note: If a construction project indicates potential overcharging, this may limit the inclusion of Minimum Property Requirements (MPRs) or Reasonable Accommodations (RAs) that are essential to assisting SAH or SHA eligible Veterans with their independence needs.





Cost Breakdown Example A

There are various ways to develop a cost breakdown. Below is one of two examples we will show of a cost breakdown. This example breaks down the project cost based on the order in which the work will be completed, and the amounts to be paid for each disbursement after work is completed for each stage to include the 20 percent holdback.

Disbursement Schedule for SAH Construction Projects

The disbursement schedule is another important requirement for SAH construction projects.

Once you have completed the cost breakdown, you will use that to assist you in creating a proposed disbursement schedule.

Each stage of the disbursement schedule must have valueadded work, and the final stage will be a 20 percent hold back, unless it will be a turnkey project with only one payment.

Each disbursement amount will be paid to you upon a satisfactory compliance inspection, and the hold back amount will be released after the compliance and inspection **and** the VA inspection are completed and approved.

Draw Payments will be based upon completed work in place as determined by the VA assigned Compliance Inspector. A twenty percent (20%) holdback has been applied to all draw payments. The twenty percent holdback will be disbursed at completion of project


Disbursement Schedule for SAH Construction Projects, Cont.

You are expected to carry the cost of construction through the first stage, which may include payments for plans and permits along with the other completed work.

If the project cost exceeds the available grant funds, then the Veteran will be responsible for the difference and this amount must be incorporated into the schedule, with Veteran's funds being released prior to VA grant funds.

Disbursement Schedule and VA's Payment Procedures


Be detailed in the description of work expected to be completed in each stage and include an amount commensurate to the work. Typically, the first disbursement should not exceed 20 percent.

Once the grant is approved, VA will finalize this schedule on a different form. VA will send the form to you and the Veteran for acceptance. Any changes after grant approval will require a change order, which is discussed more in the Change Order lesson.

Note: In certain scenarios a third-party external escrow may be utilized.







Construction Impact on Veteran

Often, Veterans remain in the home being remodeled, and consideration should be given to the phases of construction and their impact on the Veteran's activities of daily living.



Veteran Contributions



Remember the following as it relates to the cost breakdown:

- Twenty percent (20%) of construction funds will be held back until the project is completed. These funds are payable only after receiving a satisfactory final compliance inspection report and SAH Agent final field review.
- The Veteran will contribute to the construction cost if the project goes over the grant amount.




Compliance Inspection and Disbursements



Disbursements will be authorized by VA upon the completion of each stage of construction and a satisfactory compliance inspection by the VA compliance inspector.

It is important that builders anticipate the need for a compliance inspection and communicate the completion of each stage in a manner that does not create construction delays.
