f.	TheTribe will to the maximum extent possible assist VA in its efforts to manage this program in a prudent and cost- effective manner. This will include assisting VA in finding qualified substitute purchasers if the initial borrower is unable to fulfill his or her obligations under the law, carrying out evictions, assuring that mortgages and other legal instruments can be properly recorded and otherwise assuring that the program is operated in a responsible and prudent manner.
